Program summary

The Functional Spanish for International Students (EFE) Summer Program is a four to six-week full immersion program which will take place from **June 5th to July 19th, 2017**. Students may take four, five and up to six weeks on three levels: Basic, Intermediate and Advanced.

Students will be evaluated previous to their arrival to ensure placement at the correct level.

The program includes:

- Language courses focusing on the four abilities: Speaking, listening, writing and reading.
- Opportunities for discussion in and outside of the classroom.
- Cultural activities such as dance classes (Cali is known as the Salsa capital of the world), cultural and social activities aimed at enriching the immersion program.
- Access to all of the university campus: swimming pool, soccer field, gym, library and all other facilities.

Note: Weeks 2, 3 and 4 will be four day weeks due to national holidays.

Objectives

1 Linguistic

- 1.1 To improve the participants' knowledge of Spanish.
- 1.2 To improve fluency in communication in both academic and social situations.
- 1.3 To develop reading and writing skills.
- 1.4 To strengthen grammar and increase Spanish vocabulary.



2 Cultural

- 2.1 To better understand and appreciate the cultural identity of Cali, Valle del Cauca, and Colombia.
- 2.2 To be able to interact with Spanish-speakers in different situations.
- 2.3 To learn about local idioms and expressions used in everyday life, especially in the region.
- 2.4 To get to know the country through socio-cultural experiences in different contexts, films, videos, photos and guided tours.
- 2.5 To become familiar with some texts and Colombian authors.

3 Academic

- 3.1 To encourage the understanding of the contextual application of the different disciplines.
- 3.2 To encourage networking and engagement with the environment.
- 3.3 To support the constant flow of ideas to impact the academic quality of our organizations.
