## SPAIN VISA INSTRUCTIONS



## ABOUT THE PROCESS

The Study Abroad Office will send a staff member on your behalf to apply for your visa during the semester before you go abroad.

For Fall programs, you will be without your passport from approximately May – July. For Spring programs, you will be without your passport from approximately Oct – Dec (*do not plan to travel over Thanksgiving*).

The visa process takes around 4 weeks from the day all documents are presented at the Spanish consulate in San Francisco and will be returned to you directly by mail.

## WHAT TO SUBMIT:

Participants studying abroad in SPAIN should gather and complete the following materials by the deadline provided by the Study Abroad office.

- <u>National visa application form</u>: The application forms must be signed and filled out in print. Use blue ink and don't sign it until you turn your materials to the Gonzaga Study Abroad staff. <u>http://www.exteriores.gob.es/Consulados/SANFRANCISCO/en/ConsularServices/Documents/visas/SolicitudNacionalEN.pdf</u>
- 2. <u>Original Passport:</u> Passport valid for a minimum of 6 months after the intended date of departure from Spain, with at least one blank page to affix the visa.
- 3. Copy of passport identification page.
- 4. <u>Provide proof of residency</u>: A copy of your Driver's License and GU ID on the same page.
- 5. <u>Two passport sized photos</u>: (White Background, 2x2in). If you are going to St. Louis University Madrid, you will have turned these in during the application process. If you are going to Granada, you will need 8 photos total!
- 6. <u>Planned Round Trip itinerary printout</u>: This just needs to be the print out of what you PLAN to buy. You can purchase your flight once you've been officially accepted and approved for the program.
- 7. <u>Self-addressed</u>, <u>pre-paid USPS flat-rate envelope</u>: Bring a pre-paid self-addressed express mail envelope of the US Postal Service with \$22.95 postage. Not metered stamps. This is for the Consulate to return your passport to you.
- 8. <u>Visa Fee</u>: Cash for \$160.00.
- 9. <u>Completed Notarized Appointment of Legal Representation Form</u>. You'll fill this out when you turn in all the other items.
